<u>General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) — Privacy Notice, Roadworks Control Section</u>

Your information is collected to process an application to place a Vehicle / Hoist / Cherry picker / Equipment on a public road or footpath. The legal basis for this is provided for under Section 72 of the Road Traffic Act 1993. Information collected by us is generally limited to the location of the proposed vehicle/hoist/cherry picker/equipment and your contact details. Debit or credit card details, if provided, are deleted as soon as payment is confirmed.

The information (other than credit card details) may be shared internally with:

- Other sections within the Environment & Transportation Department whose assistance is necessary to process work associated with your request.
- Other departments within Dublin City Council for the purpose of providing a record of road & footpath use

Your information may be retained for a minimum of 6 years as part of the record of traffic management in Dublin City Council's administrative area.
